



Step 1: Architectural Information

The THX Design Office conducts a room, equipment and site plan evaluation, free of charge, prior to beginning design work. In order for THX to conduct this evaluation, the THX Site and Screen Form and architectural drawings must be submitted to the Design Office, design@thx.com, for each room under consideration.

Site and Screen Form: This form provides the Design Office with the contact, equipment, and architectural information necessary for the review. Additionally, a THX Certified Studio or Cinema must use equipment from the THX Approved Equipment list, which can be found at www.thx.com.

The Design Office requires the following scaled architectural drawings to complete the evaluation process. These drawings can be submitted in .dwg, .dxf, or .mcd formats:

- Complete floor plan drawings, including a seating plan
- Elevation drawings of the sidewalls and projection wall
- Architectural detail of the ceiling
- Detail of all isolation wall construction
- All mechanical drawings including HVAC drawings

Step 2: Proposal & License Agreement

When the studio or cinema passes this preliminary review, THX will send you a certification proposal, followed by a certification agreement.

Step 3: Design Services

The THX Design Office works directly with your staff, project architects, acoustical consultants, contractors, and equipment installers. The THX design package of architectural and technical drawings is designed specifically for each room.

Step 4: Testing

THX assists in scheduling a certification test date with a qualified representative once your room is ready for testing. Please make sure to review the THX Pre-Certification Checklist prior to scheduling.

Step 5: Certification

When the room successfully passes the THX performance tests, it is THX Certified.
